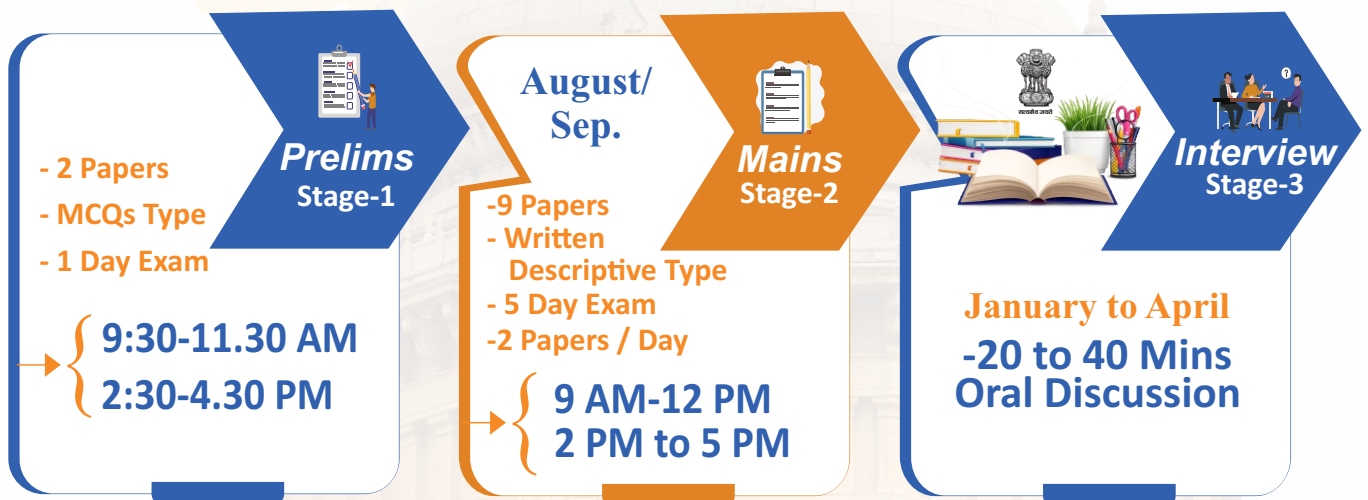


## CSE EXAM PATTERN AND SYLLABUS

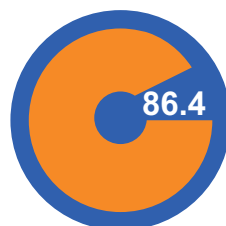

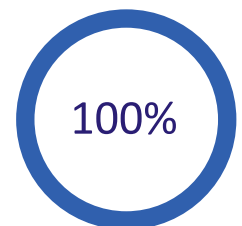
